#### Definitions

**Personal Data**: (Article 4, Section 1, EU Regulation 2016/679): Any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"). An identifiable person can be identified directly or indirectly by reference to an identifier such as a name, ID number, location data, or online identifier.

**Processing**: (Article 4, Section 2, EU Regulation 2016/679): Any operation or set of operations performed on personal data or sets of personal data, such as collection, recording, organization, storage, adaptation, extraction, consultation, use, communication, or erasure.

## **Rights of Data Subjects**

Data subjects have the following rights under the EU Regulation:

- Access to Personal Data (Article 15): The right to confirm whether personal data is being processed and access information about the purpose, categories of data, recipients, retention period, and existence of automated decision-making, including profiling.
- 2. **Rectification** (Article 16): The right to correct inaccurate or incomplete personal data without undue delay.
- 3. Erasure (Right to be Forgotten) (Article 17): The right to delete personal data if:

It is no longer necessary for the purposes collected.

Consent has been withdrawn.

Processing is unlawful or not justified.

- 4. **Restriction of Processing** (Article 18): The right to limit data processing under specific circumstances, such as disputed accuracy or unlawful processing.
- 5. **Data Portability** (Article 20): The right to receive personal data in a structured, commonly used format and transmit it to another data controller.
- 6. **Objection** (Article 21): The right to object to processing based on legitimate interests or direct marketing.
- Not Being Subject to Automated Decision-Making (Article 22): The right not to be subjected to decisions based solely on automated processing that produce legal effects or significantly affect the individual.

## Filing a Complaint

If a data subject believes their rights have been violated, they can file a complaint with the **Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali** (Data Protection Authority) at <u>http://www.garanteprivacy.it</u>.
